This spacious master bedroom suite features seven windows, plus a French door to the patio. While all these windows and the glorious mountain views they open onto were one of the major reasons the clients fell in love with this home, they quickly discovered they were unable to get a good night's sleep without some kind of window coverings.

In the bedroom, traversing drapery panels with blackout lining were the first step, but there was still plenty of light coming from the sitting area. These angled windows were an architectural feature the clients didn't want to lose, so Tennille Wood created a series of shaped valances that fit snug to the vaulted ceiling, with motorized shades underneath, for both light control and maximum views when raised.

The same design was used on the window to the left of angled windows, while a traversing blackout drapery is used on the French door. A valance was then added to the bedroom windows to help tie all the designs together.
